## On Highway 61

THE magic of one of the greatest rock artists of all time will be recreated next month with a little help from his original band members.

Highway 61 Revisited reunites two musicians from Bob Dylan's backing band: violinist Scarlet Rivera and bassist Rob Stoner, who appeared on the *Desire* album and Rolling Thunder Revue tour of 1975-1976.

The show will feature the songs that made Dylan a cultural icon including *Knockin' on Heaven's Door*, *Like a Rolling Stone*, *Tangled Up in Blue* and *All Along the Watchtower* as well as new hits like *Things Have Changed*.



With an acoustic and an electric set, fans of all ages can revisit the Dylan experience or hear it for the first time.

The poetry, symbolism, and power of the folk-rock pioneer's greatest performances still resonate today, thanks to Highway 61 Revisited.
